
Video: 10 Screenwriting Tips from Taika Waititi

Here are some of those writing tips:

The easy way ultimately becomes the hard way, because you pay the price which is mediocre work.

No matter how unconventional your characters are, always make them more human and more relatable.

Failure is a brilliant thing. It teaches you what not to do and you end up coming up with better ideas.

Start with the beginning and the end, then figure out the scenes in between. Outline your whole story, and only then start the actual writing. tip

Filtering your writing is key to ensure your scripts aren't bloated.

Remember that film is an escape, so don't be afraid to embrace human absurdity in your writing and find the right balance between humor and drama.
